This is for information to all concerned that after completion of Counseling by West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination Board 2026, some of the seats still remained vacant in B.Sc. Nursing and GNM Nursing in the Non Government Nursing Institutions in West Bengal.

Now, in order to fill up the vacant seats in B.Sc. Nursing Course, candidates appeared in JENPAS-UG 2026 & NEET-UG, 2026 having domicile in West Bengal will be allowed for admission in the Non-Government Institutions to fill up the vacant seats in B.Sc. Nursing Course, However they should fulfil the minimum academic and eligibility criteria for appearing in JENPAS-UG, 2026 and having the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) and the WBJEEB in their Information Bulletin of JENPAS-UG, 2026.

In GNM Course candidates having qualification of 10+2 passed and having the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) and having domicile in West Bengal are allowed to take admission in Non-Govt. Institutions.

This will be applicable only for the academic session 2026-2027.
