teachers' responsibility


- KPC teachers are responsible for :

courses



COURSES

The institution offers courses in medical disciplines at the undergraduate level. The program is recognized by the Medical Council of India and the college is affiliated to West Bengal University of Health Sciences. The college admits 150 students for the MBBS course per academic year.



MBBS Duration

5 1/2 Years (including internship period of one year)

ELIGIBILITY

CITIZENSHIP: Indian nationals and eligible foreign students.

DATE OF BIRTH: Individuals born on or before 11-12-1998 are eligible to apply.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates shall be allowed to be admitted in KPC Medical College with the following eligibility criteria:

▶ He/she shall complete the age of 17 (seventeen) years on or before 31-12-2015 He/she should have passed qualifying examination, ie. Higher Secondary Examination or ICSE Examination or CBSE Examination or any Examination equivalent to 10 + 2 level from any recognized Board / University, securing at least 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry & Biology They should also have English as one of the compulsory subjects at 'A' Level not less than the core course for English as prescribed by the National Council for Educational Research and Training after the introduction of 10 + 2 + 3 years educational structure as recommended by the National Committee on Education.

OR

- ▶ Intermediate Examination in Science of an Indian University/Board or other recognized Examination Body with Physics, Chemistry & Biology, which shall include a practical test in these subjects and also English as a compulsory subject.
- ▶ The candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- ▶ Any other examination which, in scope and standard is found to be equivalent to the intermediate science examination of an Indian University/Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology including practical test in each of these subjects and English.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION

All the students who qualify for admission, will be subjected to medical examination prior to admission. Any student found disabled grossly interfering with his pursuing MBBS course will not be admitted.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The Entrance Examination will be of Objective Type Multiple Choice Question
- The duration of the test will be two hours commencing from 12 noon to 2 pm

TEST SYLLABUS — The questions on Physics, Chemistry, Biology would be based on the 10 + 2 syllabus followed by WBJEE, ICSE, CBSE etc.

MERIT LIST — Based on the marks obtained in the Entrance Test 2015, the lists of the successful candidate will be displayed on 17/07/15 in the notice board of KPC Medical College and in the College website.

COUNSELLING — Candidates are required to go through counseling procedure on 20/07/15 and 21/07/15. Second Counciling of required on 27/07/2015.

CURRICULUM

The curriculum follows the directives of the Medical Council of India. The institution's academic program is built on comprehensive emphasis on all aspects of the medical science and healthcare practices with the objective of producing medical professionals who are fully equipped to serve the society.

RULES & REGULATIONS

College hours

- a. The college hours for first professional, ie. 1st and 2nd semester students will be 8.00 am 4.00 pm, with a lunch break of 45 minutes.
- b. For second professional, i.e. 3rd semester to 5th semester college hours will be 9.00 am 5.00 pm with lunch break of 45 minutes.
- c. Attendance will be marked at the commencement of each Theory/ Practical/ Demonstration class.

If Leave Rules

▶ The institution maintains a strict policy pertaining to leave and absence. Prior permission is mandatory for leaving the station, but not more than 2 days at a time. ▶ For more than 2 days leave, Principal's permission is required. ▶ For leaves due to medical reasons, medical certificate from Regd. Medical practitioner is a must along with fitness certificate at the time of joining back.

III Holidays

College will follow Govt. of West Bengal holidays as per Govt. notification.

IV Students are to compulsorily attended regular course of study for the prescribed period as per college routine. The attendance also includes non lecture classes like demonstration, practical, tutorial, seminar, group discussion, clinical posting, community posting.

The recording of attendance of all subjects including clinical subjects like General Medicine, General Surgery, Obs & Gynae, Paediatrics, Ophthalmalogy, ENT, etc. will commence from the start of such instruction till the final examination is conducted on the subject.

Attendance will be periodically published at the end ofeach semester for the benefit of the students. There is no provision for condonation of shortage of attendance (due to any cause whatsoever).

V Internal Assessment

It is based on continuous evaluation (may be daily/weekly/fortnightly/monthly/bi-monthly) of the student. The program of continuous assessment consists of evaluation with the instruments like item cards/Oral/Practical/short questions/multiple choice question test/problem solving exercise after the completion of an item, part/region or system. Each test shall be objectively assessed and recorded. There shall be two periodical internal assessment examinations. Considering that the classes of the 1st professional MBBS will start by the 3rd week of August, the first periodical internal assessment Examination will be held in the 2nd & 3rd week of January and the second one in the 1st & 2nd week of June. All the classes will remain suspended during these weeks for holding the periodical IA examination. Fifty (50) percent of the marks in internal assessment, earmarked for theoretical and practical components shall be allotted for continuous assessment based on day-to-day performance recorded properly. For this purpose item cands or other methods will be chosen. Marks secured in the two periodical assessment examinations will count for awarding the other 50% marks. Marks awarded in theory and oral parts of internal assessment, and the practical parts of the continuous assessment and periodical assessment examination will constitute the total internal annual marks.

Computation of the Internal Assessment Marks


A student in order to be eligible to sit for the University examinations, must secure at least 35% of the marks fixed for internal assessment in all the subjects separately. Internal assessment marks of a student in one or more failed subjects in the University examination shall remain to his/her credit for consideration in the subsequent University examination in that subject.


VI Code of Conduct

MCI recommended guidelines on Prevention of Ragging - Anti-raging Measures and punishment for violation.

MANDATORY LEGAL PROVISIONS FOR CURBING MENACE OF RAGGING IN MEDICAL COLLEGES (as directed by MCI on the recommendation of Prof. Raghavan Committee appointed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide Notification No. MCI-34(1) 2009 - Med/54880 dt.27/03/09)

- 1 Every student for the purpose of his/her admission to Medical College shall furnish a Character Certificate from the institution wherefrom he/she has passed his qualifying examination, which would mention the status of his/her behavioural pattern specially in terms as to whether he/she has displayed persistently violent or aggressive behaviour or any desire to harm others.
- 2. An annual undertaking signed by each student, whether fresher or senior and his/her parent(s) jointly stating that each of them has read the relevant instructions/regulations against ragging, as well as punishments, and that if the ward has been found guilty, he/she shall be proceeded against, shall be procured.
- Such an undertaking shall be furnished in English as well as in vernacular (mother tongue of the parent) at the beginning of each academic year by every student.
 - 4. An undertaking to the similar effect will have to be obtained every year from each student permitted to stay in the hostel.
- Complaints against ragging, if received from any student or their parents or from any third party whether oral or written, will be thoroughly investigated by constituted committees. Strict confidentiality will be maintained at all costs in this regards.









FACILITIES

✓ Classrooms with state of the art infrastructure

There are three fecture theatres, one with capacity 180, one with capacity 240 & one with capacity 520. One lecture theatre is fully air conditioned. Seminar rooms and demonstration rooms are available in each department. The rooms are well ventilated with proper lighting system, built in and portable writing boards, equipped with LCD Projector, Overhead Projector, Computers with high waitage audio aids.

✓ Library

The college library is well stocked with books on all branches of study located in the ground floor of college building. The library also subscribes to Indian and foreign journals on medical and alled subjects. The linge 12840 sq. ft. library has got wireless internet connectivity and there is a separate internet browsing room equipped with computers. The library has a 50 seated computer lab. The library has also facilities for video cassette and CDs. The library remains open from 9.00 am to 8.00 pm.

✓ Hostel


College has got separate hostels for boys and girls with well furnished nomes, visitors' room, Warden's office, security guards and mess facilities.

For day-to-day problems of the hostellers, separate Warden and Assistant Wardens have been nominated for boys and girls hostels. Hostellers are strictly required to follow rules and regulations for the lostel as has been framed by the KPC Medical College & Hospital Society.

Hostellers are allowed to leave the hostel/campus between 5.00 pm & 8.00 pm (during winter, ie. 15 Nov.—15 Mar) and 6.00 pm & 9.00 pm (during summer, ie. 16 Mar.—14 Nov). Hostellers are required to seek prior permission from their hostel wardens if absence from the hostel is needed much more than this specified period when they want to visit home town for festivals or for any other reason for more than 3 days Students are supposed to seek prior permission from the College Principal subject to no-objection from parents and concerned warden. All such students should sign hostel register about date and time of leaving and arrival, to be counter checked by wardens. Hostellers should keep with them their ID cards as and when they leave the hostel and give their contact numbers and address in cases of emergencies.

All hostellers should be present in the hostel by 9.00 pm Hostel





main gate shall be closed by 9.00 pm sharp daily. Students are not allowed to repaint their rooms' interior or make any structural /electrical changes without prior permission of the competent authorities.

Parents/guardians and visitors are allowed to visit hostels from 5.00 pm - 8.00 pm but not permitted to stay in the hostel overnight.

Use of alcohol and intoxicating drugs are completely banned in the college campus and hostellers/students violating these rules will be subjected to strict disciplinary action.

√ Sports

To encourage students for participation in various sports activities — college has provided spacious well-planned fields for football, hockey, basketball, badminton, along with indoor games like table tennis and carrom.

Students selected for District/State/National level sports meets will be considered for College Medals and other recognitions.

√ Transport

The College provides transport to all students to attend their "Field posting" and all external training programmes that are part of their curriculum.

√ Postal / Bank / STD facilities

All major bank branches and their ATM counters are located in the vicinity of the college. Some bank branches are just across the road. Efforts are being made to open a branch of a leading bank inside the campus. ATM counters of two banks are already there inside the campus. Post office and Telegraph office are located at a stone's throw distance. Though STD booths are available outside premises, we intend to setup a business center in-side the campus shortly where STD booth, photocopy facility, travel desk would be provided.


KPC Medical College Hospital is situated in the college campus and it is interconnected with medical college building through a wide corridor.








DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY

It has a big practical laboratory having all necessary equipments for undergraduate training. There is one well-equipped Resarch Laboratory. Equipments for protein and DNA isolation and characterization available. There is one service laboratory that is situated in the hospital catering to the need of all the modern investigation necessary for hospital service. There is also one air-conditioned laboratory having one auto analyzer and semi auto analyzer and one ELISA reader with auto washer, All kinds of hormone analysis are being done here.







DEPARTMENT OF TUBERCULOSIS & RESPIRATORY DISEASES




DEPARTMENT OF FORENSIC MEDICINE & TOXICOLOGY



Majumder is the Head of the Department. The department is having a fully equipped modern autopsy complex for conducting medicolegal autopsy cases for demonstration to students.



















DEPARTMENT OF MEDICINE






DEPARTMENT OF DERMATOLOGY, VENEROLOGY & LEPROSY


DEPARTMENT OF ORTHOPAEDICS



DEPARTMENT OF CLINICAL DIETETICS & COMMUNITY NUTRITION DIVISION



Keeping this aim in view MBBS training programme has been scheduled to provide extensive exposure and extending it to the community based training areas through Urban Training Centre at Sonarpur and Rural Training Centre at Sonarpur Rural Hospital, Subhashgram, Eaculty members and specialists from Obstetric & Gynaecology, Pediatric, General Medicine, General Surgery, Orthopaedics and ENT dept. are also involved in the community based teaching and training programme including all other medical programme.







DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRY
